Please note that this communication means requires only a standard modem at the central PC. This connectivity link can be applied to Analog PSTN and ISDN telephone lines.

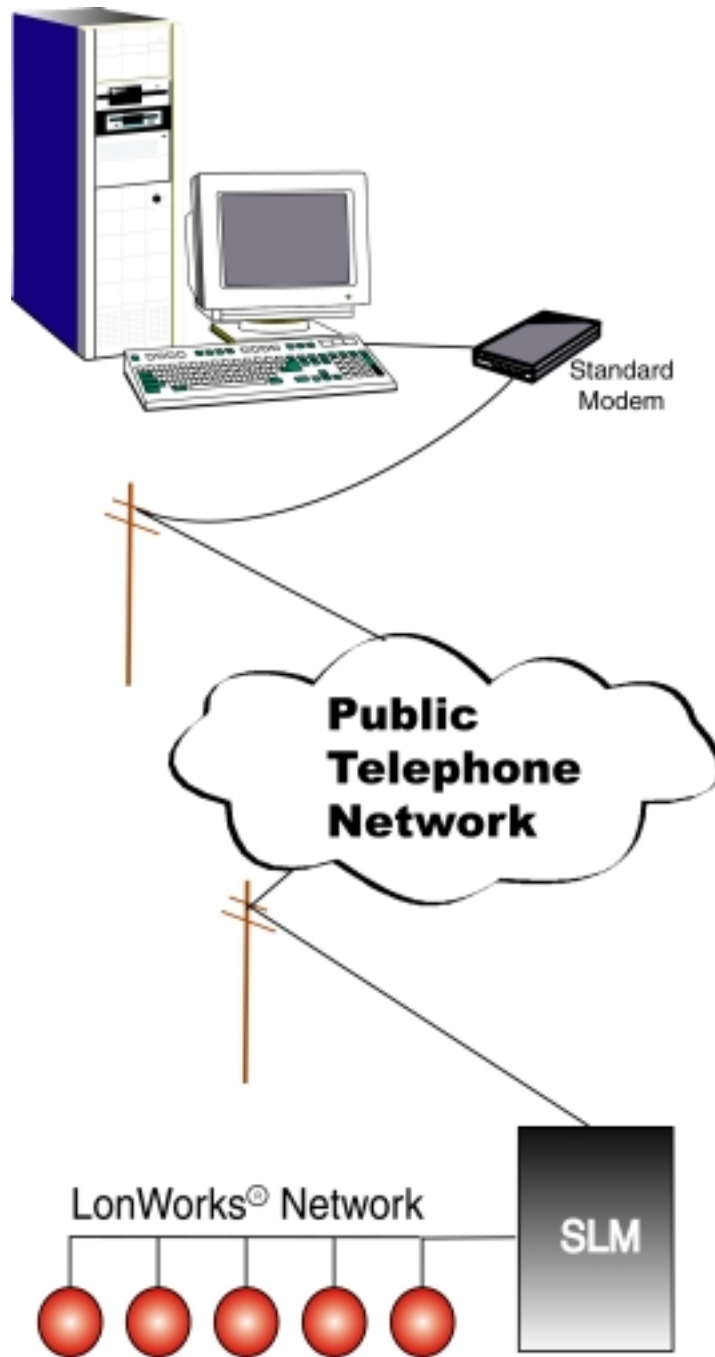
